About us

Teaching law and administrative sciences for three decades.

The story of the **Faculty of Law and Administrative Sciences** (FDSA) begins in 1992, when the Law programme was established within the **Faculty of Letters, History, Law and Theology**. Public Administration followed in 1995, and two years later the **Faculty of History and Administrative Sciences** (1997-1998) emerged, later known as the **Faculty of History, Law and Administrative Sciences** (1998-2002).

In 2002, the first decade of Ovidian legal higher education was celebrated within the **Faculty of Law** as an independent structure, comprising two programmes: Law and Public Administration. Its current name was first introduced in 2005, anticipating the addition of two new programmes of study: Local Police (originally Community Police) and Managerial and Administrative Assistance (originally Managerial Assistance and Secretariat), both commencing in 2008.

From 2009 to 2013, subsequent to the creation of a Sociology programme, FDSA was known as the **Faculty of Law, Administrative Sciences and Sociology**. The return to its current name, shortly after celebrating two decades of Ovidian legal higher education, reflects a firm commitment to persevere in establishing a school of law and administrative sciences truly representative of the „realm between the Danube and the Sea“, fully integrated in the Romanian and European system of higher education.

Having reached its third edition, the Ovidius Summer School aims to foster dialogue and cooperation among the students of the many legal and administrative higher education institutions in Romania.

The papers will be defended publicly on 30 August. Contestants are allowed to use PowerPoint presentations. The best papers will be distinguished during the award ceremony.
